ELECTION OF OFFICERS—ARTICLE II

Sec. 3. No member shall be entitled to vote at the Annual Election or  
 be eligible to any office unless his dues shall have been paid in full to  
 St. John's Day next succeeding such election or the same duly remitted  
 by vote of the Lodge.

Sec. 4. Before proceeding to the election, the Secretary shall read a  
 list of the members who are in arrears to the Lodge; whereupon the  
 Worshipful Master shall announce that such members are **not eligible**  
**to office nor entitled to vote.**

DUES—ARTICLE VI

Sec. 1. The dues of each member shall be six dollars per year, ex-  
 cept when otherwise provided by these By-Laws.

Sec. 2. Any member being in arrears to the Lodge for two or more  
 years on the night of the Annual Election, and neglecting or refusing  
 to pay the same after he has been summoned by action of the Lodge,  
 at the next preceding stated meeting to pay his arrears, or show cause  
 why he should not be suspended for non-payment thereof, may be sus-  
 pended from membership; **provided**, that before any member be suspended  
 it shall satisfactorily appear to the Lodge that such member, has, in  
 addition to such summons, received due notice as required by Article  
 III, Section 3, of these By-Laws and that the provisions of the Ahimanu-  
 Rezon have been fully complied with.
