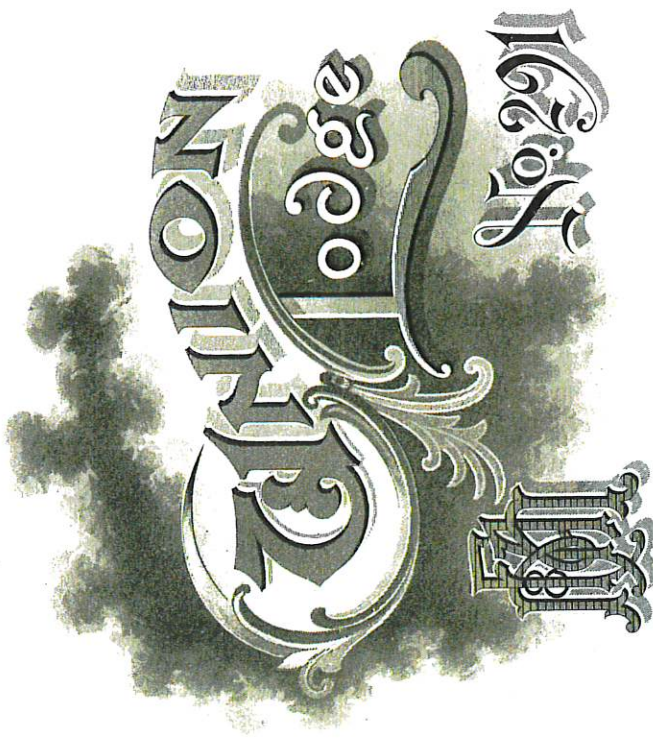

## *A Red Letter Day in Freemasonry*

Dear Brother:

The outstanding event in connection with the Bi-Centennial of the birth of George Washington, from a Masonic standpoint, will be the dedication of the Memorial to George Washington, the Man and Mason, at Alexandria, Va., Thursday, May 12, 1932, at 12:00 o'clock noon.

Local Masons, in common with those throughout Pennsylvania, have had a deep interest in this movement from its inception, as has been proven by the generous contributions made by Lodges and individual brethren.

Past Grand Master Louis A. Watres has served continuously as President of the Association; this gives an unusual local interest to Masons in Northeastern Pennsylvania and those of the Thirteenth District in particular.

A committee composed of one representative from each of the fifteen Lodges of Scranton and surrounding towns have charge of the details and arrangements for all Lodge members and their families who desire to make the trip to and from Washington in connection with the dedication.

The various railroads and bus companies are scheduling special trips, both from Scranton and Wilkes-Barre. These trips include just transportation cost, approximately \$10.00; to special tours from May 11th to 13th, all expenses at approximately \$20.00. Special stop-over privileges can be arranged if desired.

For those who desire to make the trip by automobile, the committee will also furnish information as to the best routes, etc.

It is the earnest desire of the committee that as large and as representative a body as possible make the trip from each Lodge.

The time is limited and reservations should be made immediately.
