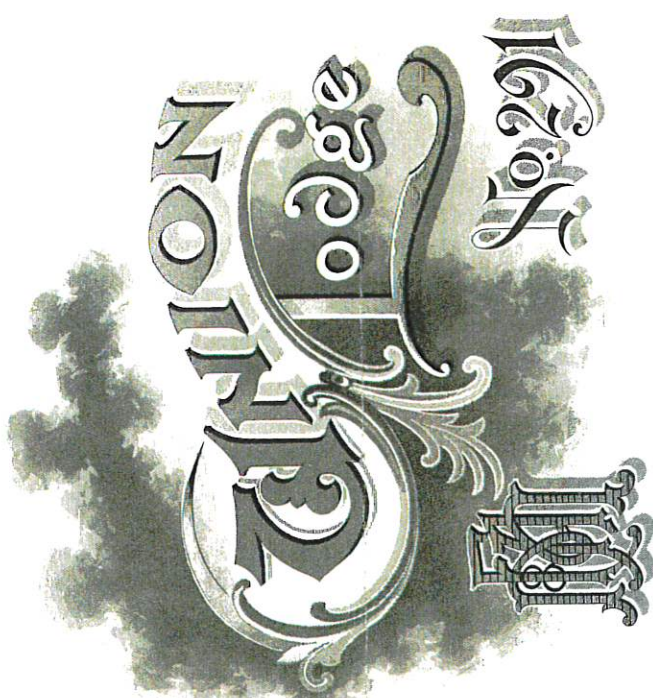

EXTRACTS FROM THE BY-LAWS

ARTICLE VI, SEC. 1. The dues for each member shall be \$12.00 per annum, except when otherwise provided by these By-Laws.

SEC. 2. Any member being in arrears to the Lodge for two or more years on the night of the annual election, and neglecting or refusing to pay the same after he has been summoned by action of the Lodge at the next preceding stated meeting to pay his arrears or show cause why he should not be suspended for non-payment, may be suspended from membership; Provided that before any member be suspended, it shall satisfactorily appear to the Lodge that such member has, in addition to such summons, received due notice as required by Article III, Section 3, of these By-Laws, and that the provisions of the Ahiman Rezon have been fully complied with.

Dues mailed to the Secretary will be promptly acknowledged.

The School of Instruction will meet in the Masonic Temple-Scottish Rite Cathedral on the first and second Wednesday evenings of the month at 7:30. All Master Masons cordially invited.

The solicitation of a petitioner for initiation and membership before he has received the degree of Master Mason, for membership in an organization which has as a pre-requisite membership in the Masonic Fraternity, is forbidden as being conduct unbecoming a Mason.

Notify the Secretary by phone or card when you change your address—this saves an expense to the Lodge. In case of sickness or death, notify the Master.
