Masonic Dress—White Gloves

The Master is responsible for the proper attention to and disposition of all pending petitions. No excuse will be accepted for non-compliance with the following law:

EVERY COMMITTEE IS TO BE NOTIFIED THAT

When a Committee fails to report within FOUR MONTHS the Master must declare the petitioner rejected as per Form No. 37, Form for Recording Minutes; unless he has died or removed from the Jurisdiction (State of Pennsylvania), making it impossible for the Committee to call on him and perform its duty. In such a case the Master must declare the petition null and void, as per Form No. 33, page 9, Form for Recording Minutes.

A Lodge may act on a petition not exceeding four months after its presentation.

If the four months expire at a time when the meetings are omitted the report may be made at the first Stated Meeting of the Lodge which shall occur thereafter.

Stated Meetings omitted are to be counted, see Sections 2 and 3, pages 66 and 67, Ahiman Rezon.
